THE HUGGER BRIDGE



DENTAL BRIDGE: A bridge is a restoration which replaces one or more teeth. There are two types of bridges-fixed and removable. Fixed bridges are bonded into place using adjoining teeth as supports. Removable bridges can be removed for cleaning, but can be less desirable than fixed bridges under certain circumstances.

Why choose a bridge to replace a tooth? When a tooth is lost, nearby teeth may tilt toward the empty space, or the teeth in the opposite jaw may move up or down toward the space. This places stress on both the teeth and tissues in your mouth. A bridge helps maintain the natural shape of your face and may help support your lips and cheeks. Missing teeth can also affect the way you chew and speak.
